IN INDIRECT SERVICE OR CIVIC ACTION, TEENS GET FEEDBACK ON THE IMPACT OF THEIR SERVICE.

- VIDEO SHOWING IMPACT
- RECIPIENT OF SERVICE SENDS A NOTE OR COMES TO THANK YOUTH IN PERSON.
- 1-2 TEENS LEAVE CAMPUS TO SEE THE IMPACT & REPORT BACK.

CELEBRATION REINFORCES TEENS' PRIDE & CONFIDENCE THAT THEY CAN HAVE AN IMPACT.

CELEBRATION HAPPENS WITH RECIPIENTS OF SERVICE WHEN POSSIBLE & APPROPRIATE.

TEENS ENGAGE IN REFLECTION AS PART OF CELEBRATION.
